


How we do this:

## Old Uniforms we turn into yarns

Uniform clothes are put into very small pieces and then shredded into pulp. From this pulp new solid yarns are created.

Colored with minimal water and nochemicals in any desirable color

## 2 Parns ready? Developed in Holland!

In Tilburg, Holland, we develop, knit and test socks. Sampling at rocket-speed...





Next step:

Data from the knittingcenter is send to the factory. Yarns are made in bulk and send also to the knitting location

## vodde is value

Vodde is dutch for 'rags'. The Ragman collected worn-out clothings in the early days door by door. He brought this to factories where they made paper from rags, mostly banknote paper.

We still believe in the value of rags and act on a large scale as the Ragman did: Creating value from worn goods
